

SPORTING EVENT REGULATIONS

FOOD / DRINK ALLOWED NO BAGS PERMITTED

All allowed drinks must be in a sealed container; no glass containers. No personal water containers allowed, unless empty.

Emergency Action Plan (EAP)

Sport: High School Volleyball, Basketball, Wrestling, Cheer, Pom, etc.

Activate the EAP:

- Any loss of consciousness
- Possible Spine Injury
- Dislocation, Open Fracture, Displaced Closed Fracture
- Difficulty or absent breathing or pulse
- Uncertainty of if you have a medical emergency

First to Arrive until Chain of Command is Established:

Check the scene.

Is it safe for you to help?

What happened?

How many victims are there?

Can bystanders help?

Chain of Command and Assigned Duties:

Leader:

- -Take charge of scene
- -Determine level of consciousness
- -Check the athlete's Airway, Breathing, and Circulation (pulse)
- -Immediate Care (First Aid, CPR)
- Check airway/breathing/circulation, level of consciousness, and severe bleeding.
- -Send for AED and/or request the call be made for Emergency Medical Services.

Leader's Assistant:

- -Will assist AT or Leader
- -Will assist with crowd control

Phone Caller:

- -Will access the nearest phone and contact EMS.
- -Will inform the dispatcher of:
 - -Nature of the injury, name and age of the injured individual.
 - -Will not hang up until dispatcher advises him/her to do so.

Directions:

From Yukon Parkway:

Enter the YHS complex.

Turn RIGHT at the dead end; front of YHS.

Turn LEFT at the second driveway (Large NE parking lot)

Enter the far south door on East side of building

From Vandement:

Turn SOUTH at Independence Intermediate School.

Turn LEFT at the stop sign; west side of Miller Stadium

Continue along north end of Miller Stadium

Enter the 2nd entrance to the large NE Parking Lot

Enter the far south door on East side of building

Equipment Retrieval:

- -Will go retrieve AED and any requested medical equipment
- -Nearest AED: Main School Hallway Outside of Gym
- -Additional medical equipment and location: Under AT Table in Gym
- -Will assist with crowd control.

Person to Meet EMS:

- -Will contact any necessary staff to assure access to ambulance (unlock gates, doors, etc.)
- -Will meet the ambulance at designated entrance and lead them to the injured individual

Person to Accompany Individual to the Hospital:

- -Will access RankOne for all pertinent information.
- -Will call emergency contact of injured individual and ask for preference of hospital for transport.
- -Will ride with the injured individual in the ambulance in the event the emergency contact cannot be located.
- -Will take the individuals emergency info to the hospital.

It is the certified athletic trainer or coach's responsibility to inform the administrator of the incident. It is the certified athletic trainer or coach's responsibility to inform the athlete's parents of the injury immediately. It is the certified athletic trainer's responsibility to document the circumstances surrounding the activity and all actions taken.

After any emergency a debriefing process will take place lead by YPS Athletic Director and YPS Athletic Trainer to determine if any necessary changes need to be made to Emergency Action Plan. This plan will be reviewed annually.
