SENATE BILL 26 AMENDMENT

If a suitable meeting room or area is not available, a coach may enter a locker room before, during, or after a school-sponsored athletic activity, provided:

a. All students present are fully clothed,

b.The coach shall be accompanied by at least one additional adult at all times,

c. If the coach is the opposite sex of the students present, the coach shall be accompanied by at least one adult of the same sex as the students present. The adult shall not be a current high school student.

IDEASTO MEET SB 26 REGULATIONS

Let's use the example of a male coach who coaches a female team.

If they go into a locker room, they must have a female adult (non-student) with them. Here are the options that one AD suggested.

- 1. Have a female on staff
- 2. Have a female administrator available
- 3. Have the coach's wife be in the meeting
- 4. Have the mother of a player in the meeting.

WEARE CONSIDERING UPDATING RULE I I

RULE II CURRENT GUIDELINES

- At least 10 days before each contest the home school must submit a sufficient and feasible list of officials to the visiting school.
- Visiting school accepts a list and can strike more than half the list.
- When a question arises, the OSSAA Board or the Executive Director shall resolve it.
