Congratulations to your school for qualifying for the State Soccer Championship Finals. Below you will find the brackets for the final round.

Tickets for the State Championships will be sold online or there will be a cash option for both championship sites. A link for the tickets can be found on the OSSAA.com homepage. Tickets will be \$11.50 after the convenience fee online or \$13.00 at the gate.

Teams that advance to the state finals and occupy the top line of the championship bracket will be the home team and wear dark-colored uniforms.

Teams that advance to the state finals and occupy the bottom line of the championship bracket will be the away team and wear white uniforms.

Changes in uniform color worn for the state finals must be a result of mutual agreement between teams playing that match. All teams will dress in the assigned locker rooms.

Teams may suit up a maximum of 22 squad members for the play-off series.

Only the team, coaches, trainers, managers, school personnel, etc., shall be permitted on the sideline during a contest. Please see the OSSAA State Championship Roster and guidelines previously sent to schools.

In the State Tournament, no contest may be started or (resumed) after 3 hours from the original scheduled start time. (Unless mutually agreed upon prior to the game.) For example, a game is scheduled to start at 6:00 p.m. if interrupted and not resumed by 9:00 p.m. it shall be considered a complete game if 60 minutes have been played. If less than 60 minutes have been played it shall be suspended for that day. (This creates a 3-hour window from start of the scheduled kick-off.)

In the State Tournament games, all matches will not be considered complete until at least 60 minutes have been played.

The overtime procedure for all playoff games is located on page SC6 of the 2023-2024 OSSAA Soccer Manual.

Anytime the score differential reaches ten at halftime or after halftime, the match will be over.

Noisemakers are allowed at outdoor activities unless they interrupt the normal game/contest procedure of announcers, bands, cheer squads, drill teams or any other game/contest-related activities. The game officials have the authority to stop the use of any noisemakers or disruptions that interrupt the normal game/contest procedures. This rule applies to both regular and post-season games or contests.

Team trophies will be presented to the state champions and runners-up. Individual medals will be given to the 22 team members of the state champions and runners-up along with a coach's achievement plaque to the head coach.


