1. Call to order.

2. Role of the committee; Protocol for advancing items on agenda.

ACTION ITEMS SUBMITTED BY ADVISORY COMMITTEE:

1. Removing the language of any other contest from all ejections, red cards, and yellow cards.

- a. Any player ejected must sit the next regularly scheduled contest on the same level of competition and **any other contest in between**. This will include all red card situations with no exceptions. This rule applies to scrimmages, regular season and play-off matches. **Yes. Unanimous.**

ii. Board Approved 6/5/2024. 11-0

ITEMS SUBMITTED FOR DISCUSSION:

1. 6 Teams from each district make the playoffs, where the top two seeds have a bye and the seeds 3-6 play in a play-in playoff round 1 the Friday of the dead week before normal playoffs would start. This would be for all classes.
 - a. Revisit the next year to see where 3A is.
2. Pay Officials in the playoffs at or better than the established regular season amounts plus travel fees.
3. Middle school representation on the advisory board. Start a database of teams and coaches. Proposal – Add 2 (Girls & Boys), (East & West).
4. OSSAA distribute district champion plaques.
 - a. Yes. Will be done administratively through OSSAA office.
5. Possibility of team camps in December and January...not 11 v 11 scrimmages but rather co-practice with another school.
 - a. Look at basketball practice model for reference. Can teams practice together?
6. Mandatory the home team MUST provide locker room space for visiting teams.
7. Overtime no golden goal...play overtime to entirety.
8. Remove the yellow card accumulation and encourage officials to use yellow cards early and often to control the game.
 - a. Continue to gather data. OSSAA Staff will gather data at summer meeting and report back.
9. Do we need to have a yellow card accumulation for coaches.
 - a. Will continue to discuss and gather information.
10. 2024-25 and 2025-26 Districts.
 - a. October meeting @ OSSAA office. 2-year cycle.
