Volleyball Uniform Specifications

In an effort to be as consistent as possible, the following template will be used as a reference point when addressing **NFHS Rule 4.2.4.c**: <u>"The body of the number must clearly contrast from the body of the uniform regardless of trim".</u>

AS EXAMPLES, ALL COLORS IN EACH GROUP BELOW ARE CONSIDERED TO **NOT CONTRAST:**

GROUP 1: BLACK, DARK GRAY, DARK GREEN, NAVY BLUE, DARK PRPLE, DARK BROWN, MAROON

GROUP 2: WHITE, YELLOW, GOLD, TAN, LIGHT GRAY, LIGHT BLUE, LIGHT GREEN

GROUP 3: PINK, RED, CARDINAL RED, ORANGE

❖ IF THE UNIFORM COLOR AND NUMBER COLOR ARE FROM THE SAME GROUP, THE UNIFORM SHOULD BE CONSIDERED OUT OF COMPLIANCE.

While these guidelines are not an exact science, it most definitely identifies color schemes that <u>DO NOT CONTRAST</u>. This same template should be used for Libero uniform top as well.

If an official declares that the colors are not clearly contrasting, they have been instructed to contact me using a form that has been provided to them. From there, I will reach out to the Athletic Director of the school, and we will address what needs to be done moving forward. Ultimately, I will have the final say in what happens from that point forward. If you have uniforms that DO NOT fit the specifications, my suggestion would be to wear something else. If you would like a ruling beforehand, feel free to contact me.
