Tickets can be purchased online: OSSAA (Oklahoma) Events and Tickets by GoFan. The price is \$8.35. The 2024-2025 OSSAA playoff pass will be the only pass accepted and must be presented with a driver's license.

Please note, we have a clear bag policy at BA. We ask for your cooperation in observing these regulations. The only bags permitted in athletic facilities are those that are clear and smaller than 12"x6"x12". Exceptions are made for cheer competitors, individuals with medical conditions and diaper bags with an accompanying child.

Team Drop Off:

- Buses may drop off teams at the southeast entrance (main entrance) to the BA EVENT CENTER. After drop off, busses need to park near track or by baseball / softball fields. (see map on page 10).
- Use the southeast doors to enter and to check in your team, 1 hour prior to their warm-up. There will be 3 floor passes allotted for coaches.

Spectators:

- Park in any lot at Broken Arrow High School or Event Center.
- Enter through the main southeast doors to BA EVENT CENTER.
- Cash ticket prices for cheer regionals are \$10.00 for students and adults.

- Doors will open at 10:00 AM for spectators.

Information about flow for coaches:

- Event check-in and entry for teams will begin 1 hour prior to the first teams warm up check-in time.
- Enter the EVENT CENTER at the front southeast entrance
- Team check in will be to the right side, when you walk in.
- You will receive a host at the event check in table that will stay with you while you wait to check in for warm ups, go through the warm-up process and after you compete until your team is back in the bleachers or has left for the day!
- o Your host will show you the bathrooms, photo booth area, concessions, coaches hospitality etc.
- Your hosts will take you to the warm up area at your warmup check in time
 - You will not be able to enter the warm up room until your check in time.
- After checking in, you will drop your bags in your designated area where they will stay until you have finished competing.
- Your team can then get ready to take your first mat.
 - You will have 7 minutes on each mat.
 - o Mat 1 will have 2 mats, mat 2 will have 3 mats, and the third mat will be a full floor.
- After warmups you will head to the on deck area (you will enter the floor from the left side if you are looking at the mat).
- Music will be played by a coach, located on the upper deck of the event center (NOT ON THE MAIN FLOOR).
- Your team will exit the mat after competing to the right side (if you are facing the mat).
- After your team competes, your hosts will take you back down the hall to get your bags from the warm up room.
- After you have retrieved your bags, you can sit in the visitors stands and watch the rest of the competition.
- Awards are in person. Immediately following the last team, please make your way to the floor for the awards ceremony.
- After awards conclude, please quickly leave the floor/building, so we can stay on schedule and start our next division. The EVENT CENTER will be cleared of all spectators after each division and will reopen 15 minutes prior to the first team competing.
- All purchases (besides GoFan tickets to the event) will be cash or venmo only.
 - We will have a limited amount of shirts available for purchase the day of the event.
 - o Concessions will be available.

Responsibility of First Supervising Staff on Scene

- Stop all activity
- · Talk with the injured athlete
- Provide first aid
- · Determine degree of injury
- · Send coach, manager or uninjured athlete to find Athletic Trainer
- Stay calm and communicate clearly action needed
 If needed, direct pre-assigned designee to call 911
 Scan area and remove anything that could harm injured athlete
 Gather adult assistance in keeping area around injured athlete clear

Responsibility of Emergency Phone Caller

- Stay Calm
- Know your location (Building name and address)
- · Clearly and concisely inform dispatcher of the following
 - Nature of injury
 - · Age of injured athlete
 - Condition of injured athlete
 - Stay online until EMS arrives

Supervisor always stays with injured athlete and directs an adult staff member to stand outside building to greet EMS and direct ambulance to best building entrance.
