



## OSSAA Cross Country Weather Protocol @ Edmond Santa Fe

### 1. Rain

- a. Once race has started, the race will finish unless lightning is detected within 10 miles.
- b. There may be a delay to a race depending on how hard it is raining. This will be left up to meet officials.

### 2. Lightning within 10 miles

#### a. Race is stopped

- i. Runners/Athletes/participants/workers move into Edmond Santa Fe's fieldhouse.
- ii. Fans/Spectators evacuate stadium and seek shelter in their vehicles.
- iii. Any team that has not unloaded, do not get out of your vehicles. Remain on your bus until the all clear is given.
- iv. Automatic 30 minute delay anytime lightning is detected within 10 miles. The OSSAA will be using Edmond Santa Fe's Perry Weather System for lightning detection.
- v. If a runner has finished the race, his/her place will be secured in the order of finish. For all runners not having finished the race before the stoppage, there will be a re-race after the delay (officials will determine how much rest time is needed before starting the next race).
- vi. The latest we will start a race is 6:30 PM.

### 3. Awards

- a. Due to rain, the awards ceremony may be moved under the home bleachers.
