Congratulations to your school on qualifying for the 2024 Class 5A Volleyball State Tournament. The tournament will be played at Moore High School on Thursday, October 24, (Quarter-Finals), Friday, October 25 (Semi-Finals) and the championship will be played at Saturday, October 26.

Below you will find the state tournament bracket for Class 5A. The tournament is a three-day single elimination format. All matches will be played the best three out of five games.

Only coaches under contract by their school, fifteen uniformed players, and a maximum of three other school-approved personnel will be admitted for free. Please be there at least thirty minutes before your scheduled first-round game.

The home team in each match will be the highest-ranked team and will sit on the right side of the scorer's table.

We will suspend the protocol of switching benches between sets.

Warm-up time before each match will be 6-6 (passing, hitting, serving) unless by mutual agreement between coaches to shorten the warm-up period. Do not start warm-ups until previous teams have left the floor.

School mascots are not allowed on the team bench. Only coaches under contract by their school, fifteen uniformed players, and a maximum of three other school-approved personnel.

NOISE MAKERS

For indoor activities: Blue-tooth speakers or any type of device that plays music, sounds, or voices, and noise makers of any kind such as air horns, cow bells, etc. will not be allowed to function/operate. This will also apply to pre-game/contest and post-game contest activities. This rule applies to both regular and post-season games/contest.

School banners, signs, and posters are not allowed to be hung inside the fieldhouse. Balloons, confetti and noisemakers are also not permitted.

Trophies will be awarded to the championship and runner-up teams. Also, fifteen (15) team members of the championship and runner-up teams will receive individual medals along with a coach's achievement plaque to the head coach of the championship and runner-up team.

The official vendor for OSSAA Championship Souvenirs – Fine Design – will be selling T-Shirts and Souvenirs at all State Championship venues. A variety of products will be available, including T-Shirts, long sleeves, hoodies, caps, sweatpants, shorts, etc. Fine Design may offer on-site customizing with school names and numbers, etc. You may also order on **Ossaa.com** under the merchandise tab.

Admission: \$10.00 Adults and Students. Tickets will be available online on the OSSAA Homepage @ ossaa.com. Cash tickets will also be available at the site.

OSSAA Board Policy: Practice or competition in athletics will not be allowed on a site after the site has been announced in any play-off activity except for the regularly scheduled contest or the host school may practice at the site if that is the team's regular practice site.

2024-2025 SPECTATOR PROCEDURES

If a student leaves during an event, the student will not be allowed to re-enter.

Students Attending Events:

All students, from both participating schools, must wear school IDs in order to attend athletic events.

Students must stay in their teams designated areas at all times.

Middle School and Elementary School students must have a guardian present and be seated with the guardian for the duration of the event.

Prohibited Items at Events:

1. Bags, backpacks, and hard binocular cases (ONLY clear bags allowed)
2. Mace and all personal protective sprays
3. Laser pointers
4. Knives
5. Guns
6. Outside food and beverages
7. All forms of tobacco, alcohol, drugs, and vapes.
8. Air horns, balls, and sporting equipment, inflatables, coolers, and containers.
9. Pets, with the exception of registered service animals.

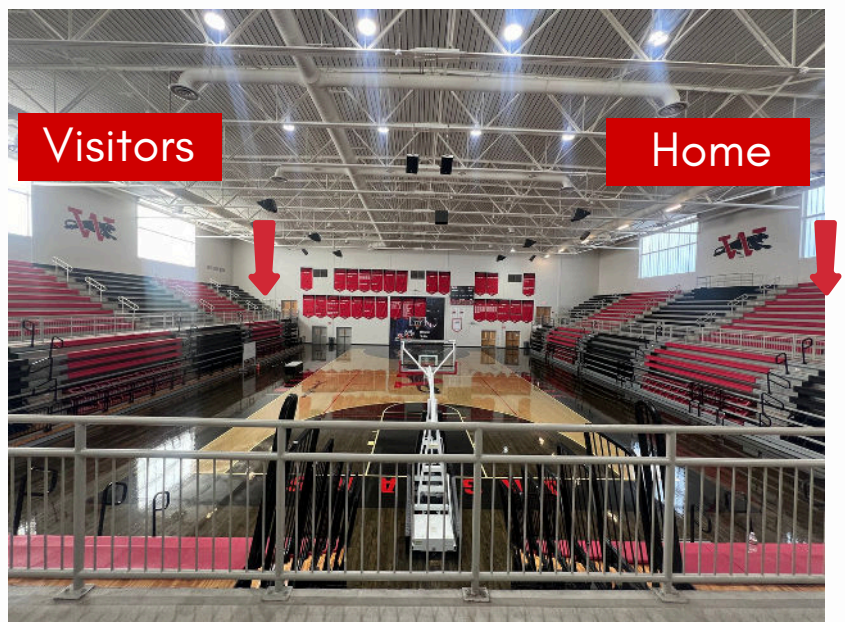
