The State Wrestling Tournaments will be held in Oklahoma City at the State Fairgrounds Arena on February 27, 28 and March 1, 2025. Reservations for your wrestlers, mat maids, etc., will be your responsibility. Hotel options are listed on the Wrestling page of the website. Listed below is additional information regarding the State Tournament:

1. Enclosed is a copy of the state tournament schedule of events.

- 2. SPIRIT SIGNS AND SCHOOL BANNERS ARE NOT ALLOWED TO BE HUNG IN THE STATE FAIRGROUNDS ARENA.
- 3. Sixth-place finishers from the regional tournaments <u>do not</u> receive a pass into the State Wrestling Tournament, only actual participants.
- 4. The number of coaches provided will be based on your school's number of qualifying wrestlers.

1 Qualifier = 2 Coaches Passes

**2-5 Qualifiers = 3 Coaches Passes** 

**6-10 Qualifiers = 4 Coaches Passes** 

11+ or more Qualifiers = 5 Coaches Passes

- Fill out the OSSAA reimbursement claim and send it to the Activities Association immediately following the State Tournament. The amount of reimbursements will be determined at the June 2025 OSSAA Board of Directors Meeting.
- 6. A maximum of two sponsors and a maximum of twelve Cheer, Pom, or Mat Maids will be admitted free. No exceptions. These groups must be in uniform, accompanied by their sponsor, and enter through the West Pass Gate. \*\*\*Only 4 Cheer or Pom members may be at the mat during a match. Once the match is concluded, they should leave the floor until the next match for their team. DO NOT SIT IN THE COACHES CHAIRS.




- 1. Coaches Packet: Coaches passes (only school-approved coaches), managers passes, participants passes, diagram of mats, bracket, tournament schedule and awards ceremony itinerary.
- 2. Please note the starting times of each session and weigh-in times.
- 3. Officials will rotate mats throughout the tournament.
- 4. Injured wrestler Certified trainers will be available along with a tournament doctor. The tournament doctor or trainer will have the final say on all injury situations.
- 5. Coaches' box is marked on the corner of all mats. Only **two coaches** in a corner.
- 6. Encourage wrestlers not to leave valuables or participant passes in the locker rooms.
- 7. If you wish to talk to an official, please go to the table and call time out. Don't talk to the official perimeter.
- 8. Sportsmanship Preach this to your wrestlers, coaches, and fans.
- 9. One Student Filmer will be allowed mat side. <u>Scorekeepers, managers, and student</u> trainers need to be in the stands and not down on the floor.
- 10. Awards Ceremony: All wrestlers must be in uniform. Head coach of the championship wrestler will be award presenter for that weight classification.
- 11. Finalists will parade in on Saturday night at approximately 5:45 p.m. (**must be in uniform or warmups and no hats**).
- 12. Pass Gate All wrestlers, managers, and coaches must show their pass at the west pass gate **no pass, no entrance**. No tickets will be accepted at the West Gate.
- 13. Cheerleaders/Mat Maids **Four per mat. NO EXCEPTIONS.** Must enter through the west pass gate and must be in uniform accompanied by sponsor. Limit 12 cheerleaders/mat maids and 2 sponsors total will be admitted. **Once the match is concluded, they should leave the floor until the next match for their team. DO NOT SIT IN THE COACHES CHAIRS.**
- 14. Certified trainer Joe Waldron (Ortho Central). School trainers are allowed on the floor, but not in the coach's corner.
- 15. Banners and signs are **not permitted** anywhere in the State Fair Arena.
- 16. Team Seating Wrestlers, managers, and mat maids/cheerleaders, will be required to sit in the upper sections on the north and south ends of the arena. Please help us with this!
- 17. No additions to the State Tournament bracket will be made after 4:00 pm on the Wednesday preceding Thursday afternoon weigh-in of the State Tournament.
- 18. There will be a 1 pass for all participants leading up to the finals. The finalists will receive a new pass for finals when turning in the information sheet. The coaches passes will work for the whole tournament. You will also be given 2 new managers' armbands for the finals.



### **WEST**

Sessions 1-4: 3A Boys, 4A Boys, and 5A Girls will wrestle on Mats 1 through 4 with a call-to-mat system.

Session 5/Finals: 3A Boys – Mat 1; 5A Girls – Mat 2; 4A Boys – Mat3



Sessions 1-4: 5A Boys, 6A Boys, and 6A Girls will wrestle on Mats 5 through 8 with a call-to-mat system.

Session 5/Finals: 5A Boys – Mat 5; 6A Girls – Mat 5; 6A Boys – Mat 7
