To Whom it may concern,

On behalf of the Oklahoma Secondary School Activities Association, I would like to thank you for your consideration in being a site for one of our Regional Golf Tournaments. We feel that it is important to provide the athletes in the state of Oklahoma with the absolute best facilities and championship experience possible. Below outline the parameters and details that we ask all potential host sites to consider when agreeing to host.

1. Regional Dates:
  - a. Girls – April 20<sup>th</sup>, 2026
  - b. Boys – April 27<sup>th</sup>, 2026
2. Event Times – start time – 8:00am
3. Event Format – Boys will play thirty-six holes (shotgun start); Girls play eighteen holes (1&10 start).
4. Number of Participants – We assign approximately 12 teams (5 members each), as well as 12 individuals to each regional site.
5. Inclement Weather – In the event that the competition must be delayed/canceled due to weather or course conditions, we ask that the course have a contingency to allow for a make-up day to have the event (the following Wednesday).
6. Cost – The OSSAA pays the following rates to the course for hosting the event: \$12.00 per player, per eighteen holes played.
7. The OSSAA will provide a host coach to organize the pairings, tee times and digital scoring. The event will have a games committee comprised of a course pro (if available) and 2 coaches.
8. Volunteers – The course will provide two starters, a score table manager, and Marshall.
9. Spectator Carts – We ask that the course make available cart rentals for fans and spectators. The number of carts and the rental price is up to each course; however, we ask that the first hour of rentals be limited to individuals with handicap placards and senior citizens.

Thank you for your consideration. Oklahoma golf is on the rise, and we could not continue to grow participation in the state if it were not for our courses and their investment in Junior Golf. Please feel free to reach out to me with any questions.
