Parking & Bus Information

Thursday, October 16th:

2025-2026 INDOOR SPECTATOR PROCEDURES

If you leave during a varsity event, you will not be allowed to RE-ENTER the event once the varsity event begins.

Student Access to Events:

Students will NOT be allowed to crossover from designated seating. Fans must remain in designated areas.

Middle and High School Students from both participating schools must have an ID and it must be worn at ALL times at the event to attend.

If the visiting school does not have student IDs, an administrator for the visiting school must be onsite to approve entry of the visiting students.

Middle School and Elementary School students must have a guardian present and be seated with the guardian for the duration of the event
