
- Cheer will shelter in the boys soccer locker room.

EMERGENCY ACTION PLAN:

Pre-Event:

- 1. Hannah Riegel, Athletic Trainer
 - a. Ensures all EMS access gates are clear and unobstructed
 - b. Checks the AED for appropriate readiness of the unit and pads
 - c. Calls a Medical Timeout with the Emergency Team prior to the event to discuss the Emergency Action Plan

In the Event of an Emergency:

- 1. Hannah Riegel, AT
 - a. Alerts Emergency Coordinator and EMS of Emergency via hand "siren" signal, arm straight and raised overhead for 3-5 seconds
 - b. Directs and Assists EMS Accordingly
- 2. Mitch McGrew, Emergency Assistant
 - a. Informs the AOOK Clinician that the EAP has been initiated and delivers the AED
 - b. Directs all unnecessary personnel away from the emergency
 - c. Assists the AOOK Clinician as necessary
 - d. Contacts EMS with the following information:
 - i. Patient age, Level of Consciousness, Breathing Status, Chief Injury
 - ii. Provides EMS with specific directions to the FB Stadium.
- 3. Sal Guerrero, Emergency Coordinator
 - a. Directs all unnecessary personnel away from the emergency
 - b. Notifies Campus Security that EMS has been summoned
 - i. Contact Host AD, inform of EMS activation, and requests EMS access point
 - ii. Alerts Emergency Coordinator of EMS access point
- 4. Coaching Staff
 - a. Directs all unnecessary personnel away from the emergency
 - b. Assists the AOOK Clinician as necessary

GENERAL GUIDELINES:

- ALL ATTENDEES ARE SUBJECT TO CHECK UPON ENTRY INTO THE GYM.
- A CLEAR BAG POLICY WILL BE IN PLACE. THIS COULD INCLUDE ZIP LOCK BAGS OR CLEAR BACK PACKS.
- NO BACKPACKS OR LARGE BAGS ARE ALLOWED INSIDE THE GYM.
- ALL SPECTATORS WILL NEED TO BE SEATED IN THE GYM DURING ANY EVENT.
- PK-5 STUDENTS MUST BE WITH AN ADULT AND SIT WITH THEM DURING THE GAME.
- 6TH-12TH GRADE STUDENTS CAN SIT IN THE STUDENT'S SECTION OR WITH PARENTS.
- NO FIREARMS OR WEAPONS OF ANY KIND.
- NO LOITERING IN THE GYM, CONCESSION AREA, OR PARKING AREAS.
- NO FANS ARE ALLOWED ON THE GYM FLOOR AT THE CONCLUSION OF THE GAME.

TICKET GATES:

- TICKET GATES WILL OPEN AN HOUR AND HALF PRIOR TO EVENT TIMES.
- THERE ARE **NO IN-AND-OUT PRIVILEGES**. RE-ENTRY REQUIRES THE **PURCHASE** OF A NEW TICKET. USE COMMON SENSE ON RE-ENTRY.
- THE OIC AND TICKET-TAKERS SHALL ENSURE THAT ALL ENTRANCES TO THE VENUES ARE **MONITORED** FOR VIOLATION OF THE RE-ENTRY PROCEDURE
