CNP Schools Spectator Guideline at Athletic/School Events

- No Re-entry Gates will be staffed throughout the duration of the event.
- Middle and High School Students from both participating schools need a **current** school year picture ID and it must be worn at all times to attend the event. Administrator(s) for the visiting school must be onsite to approve entry of the all visiting students.
- All Middle School, Elementary School students and any other student regardless of age
 from schools not competing must have a parent/guardian or chaperone present at the
 event for the duration of the event.
- No Loitering All Elementary and Middle students must be seated with a parent/guardian or chaperone.
- All students should be seated in their designated competing schools area(s)
- Students must remain on their respective side of the field with the exception of band or AFJROTC when accompanied by an adult or sponsor.
- Clear plastic tote bags 12"x 6"x 12" are permitted (1 per person)
- Non-transparent clutch wallets no larger than 6.5" x 4.5" are permitted (1 per person)
- Family care items such as diaper bags are permitted in a clear tote bag
- Bags necessary for approved medical equipment are permitted
- No other bags/backpacks are allowed

Prohibited Items:

- Explosives, firearms or weapons (Oklahoma prohibits possession of a firearm on any public or private school property)
- Alcohol (any form), Tobacco, Vapes or any other illegal substance
- Bags, backpacks, fanny packs and hard binocular cases
- Beach balls, footballs or any other sporting equipment
- Coolers, ice chest or containers
- Outside food or drinks
- Laser pointers
- Noisemakers of any type that could cause stopage of play
- Pets (with the exception of registered service animals)
- Umbrellas (Subject to search)
- Any other items deemed inappropriate by CNP Schools.

CNP Schools reserve the right to revoke/remove spectators at any time who refuse to comply with spectator guidelines.



Inclement Weather and Evacuation Precations for JIM McCHAREN ACTIVITIES CENTER

Emergency Personnel:

Certified Athletic Trainer, Student Athletic Trainers, Coaches and Administrators

Emergency Equipment:

AED located in lobby south of oncession, other equipment located in the training room

Emergency Communications:

Fixed telephones located in volleyball, baseball and basketball offices, or available mobile phor

Roles of First Responders:

- Immediate care of the injured or ill studeratthlete
- Emergency equipment retrieval
- Summon emergency medical services
- Control the scene: limit scene to emergency personnel, move bystanders from area
- Notify Certified Athletic Trainer and main office

To call an ambulance:

Call 911, and provide name, loation, phone number, number of individuals injured, condition of the injured, care administered, specific directions, and other info as requested

RE: 2025 Class 3A Volleyball State Tournament

DATE: October 10, 2025

Congratulations to your school on qualifying for the 2025 Class 3A Volleyball State Tournament. The tournament will be played at **Choctaw High School** on Thursday, October 16 (Quarter Finals) They will play on Friday October 17 (Semi Finals) and Saturday October 18 (Championship) at **Carl Albert High School**.

Below you will find the state tournament bracket for Class 3A. The tournament is a three-day single elimination format. All matches will be played to the best three out of five games.

Teams are limited to fifteen players suiting up and **only participating members** will be admitted free. Please be there at least thirty minutes before your scheduled first round game. We will not hold a coaches meeting.

The home team in each match will be the highest rated team and will sit to the right side of the scorer's table.

We will suspend the protocol of switching benches between sets.

Warm-up time before each match will be 6-6 (passing, hitting, serving) unless by mutual agreement coaches decide to shorten the warm-up period. Do not start warm-ups until previous teams have left the floor.

School mascots are <u>not</u> allowed on the team bench, only coaches under contract by their school, fifteen uniformed players, and a maximum of three other school approved personnel.

NOISE MAKERS

For indoor activities: Blue-tooth speakers or any type of device that plays music, sounds, or voices, and noise makers of any kind such as air horns, cow bells, etc. will not be allowed to function/operate. This will also apply to pre-game/contest and post-game contest activities. This rule applies to both regular and post-season games/contest.

For outdoor activities: Noise makers are allowed at outdoor activities unless they interrupt the normal game/contest procedure of announcers, bands, cheer squads, drill teams or any other game/contest related activities. The game officials have the authority to stop the use of any noisemakers or disruptions that interrupt the normal game/contest procedures. This rule applies to both regular and post-season games or contests.

School banners, signs, and posters <u>are not</u> allowed to be hung inside the fieldhouse. Balloons and confetti are not permitted. Please respect these wishes.

Trophies will be awarded to the championship and runner-up teams. Also, fifteen (15) team members of the championship and runner-up teams will receive individual medals along with a coaches' achievement plaque to the head coach of the championship and runner-up team.

The official vendor for OSSAA Championship Souvenirs – Fine Design – will be selling T-Shirts and Souvenirs at all State Championship venues. A variety of products will be available, including T-Shirts, longsleeves, hoodies, caps, sweatpants, shorts, etc. Fine Design may offer on-site customizing with school names and numbers, etc. You may also order on **Ossaa.com** under the merchandise tab.

OSSAA Board Policy: Practice or competition in athletics will not be allowed on a site after the site has been announced in any play-off activity except for the regularly scheduled contest or the host school may practice at the site if that is the team's regular practice site.

Admission: Adults - \$10.00 and Students - \$10.00. Tickets will be available online. A link is available on the OSSAA Homepage @ ossaa.com There will also be a cash option at the site.


