Action items submitted by advisory committee:

PROPOSAL:

Create a committee to do the rankings.

Table for Summer meeting and develop a plan for the 2027 season.

- Softball language on committee oversight
- Cumulative

RATIONALE:

It would be fairer and could give a more accurate ranking.

Proposal:

Move rankings to start Saturday after 5pm.

None opposed. 5 pm Saturday 5 pm Monday

Will be done administratively

Rationale:

Coaches would be able to see tournament scores. This would eliminate the coaches that rank Friday morning before a tournament starts.

Class 6A – 32

Class 5A – 40

Class 4A – 40

Class 3A – Remaining

VB coaches want to go back to 32 when the numbers grow to have a full 2A classification.
